SUMMER CLEAN-UP

The Juniata Terrace Borough will be doing a Summer Clean-Up for the Residents of the Terrace. There will be 2 dumpsters placed beside the Community Building the week of **July 11th – 19th**. If you have large boxes please be sure to break them down. **ABSOLUTELY NO TIRES or ELECTRONICS!!** If you have freon items, please place them beside the dumpster.

If you have a vehicle parked beside the Community Building you will need to move it by Thursday July 9th so the Dumpsters can be placed there.

Community Yard Sale

The Juniata Terrace Community Yard Sale will be Saturday July 25, 2020 from 7:00 AM – 1:00 PM.

Community Room Rental:

The Borough council asks when renting the Community Building to follow all CDC guidelines in place by the Commonwealth of PA.

The Borough council allows the rental of the community room to most any person or group. Juniata Terrace residents can rent the room for \$20/hour while those living elsewhere are charged \$30/hour. **No event may be scheduled in the room where alcohol will be consumed.** Any activity which may be declared illegal, such as gambling even, is also prohibited. There are no kitchen facilities in the room, but there are tables and chairs. The room is rented on a first come, first serve basis and does fill up quickly. If you are looking for a room to rent to host an event, stop and check us out.

Parking and Driving Concerns:

- ❖ ~Parking has always been an issue on the Terrace because it is so limited. **There are no personal parking spaces issued to any resident-** including handicapped parking. Residents with a handicap, either temporary or permanent, may petition the Mayor to grant a handicapped space in an accessible area near their home, but this is not a personal parking space. This space is available to anyone operating a vehicle which bears either a handicapped placard or license plate.
****Please be aware that the handicapped placard must be used by the person to which it was issued. If you are using the placard of someone who has either died or is no longer in a handicapped situation, you must surrender your placard to the local police or return it to a Pa Dot**.**
- ❖ Please remember to **watch your speed while driving through the terrace.** The speed limit is 25 mph. There are a lot of kids outside playing, riding bikes, and scooters.

Parks Garbage:

Parks will remove items other than bagged trash, but you must visit the borough office to obtain a 'sticker' for placement onto the other items. If you have a larger item which is not tagged, it will not be collected. If you have a heavy item, break it down in to several smaller, manageable pieces. If they cannot lift it, it will not be removed. Please leave your gates unlocked also to make it easier for the garbage men.

Summer Ordinances:

In an attempt to keep the borough looking and smelling nice this Spring/Summer, the Borough Council would just like to remind everyone to keep their **lawns mowed and weeds trimmed**. Also, to the owners of pets if you would please keep the dog feces in your yard cleaned up on a daily basis and make sure your yard is secure for your pets and to keep them on leashes when walking because there are a lot of young children in the Borough. To the residents who do carry bags for clean-up we would like to thank you for that and please **DO NOT** discard your dog feces on the banks behind homes of the 100, 200, and 300 blocks of the terrace.

- ❖ **Ordinance 2005-2** requires any person owning a pet to promptly remove, within 48 hours, any feces deposited in the yard. This is particularly important because of the homes/yards being so close to each other. Residents should also show courtesy to their neighbors by promptly removing animal feces so that the noxious odor does not ruin their neighbor's outdoor activities or keep them from having open windows in periods of pleasant weather. Residents may obtain a copy of the complete ordinance by visiting the borough office.
- ❖ **Ordinance 1992-1 Section 1.B.** regulates that grass must be cut to a height of four (4) inches or less and no bush, tree, etc., is permitted to grow over and onto another person's property. Again, a zero tolerance policy has been adopted by Borough Council. This ordinance also prohibits the collection of junk on porches, patios and yards. Residents may obtain a copy of the complete ordinance by visiting the borough office.
Section 2. A. No person, firm or corporation owning any property within the Borough of Juniata Terrace shall permit the accumulation or storage of any junk on said property. For the purpose of this ordinance, the term "junk" shall include any discarded material or article including, but not limited to, scrap metal, scrapped, abandoned or junked machinery, and paper or glass waste.
- ❖ **Ordinance 1999-2** restricts open fires and burning by the establishment and regulating outdoor fires within the Borough.
 - **OPEN FIRE** – a fire outside of any building in which any material is burned in the open or in a receptacle other than in a grill used for the purposes of outside barbecues.
